1st stage: Bavarian Forest National Park

Wilderness Camp at the foot of the Falkenstein, 16-25 May 2008

As well as taking part in excursions and discussion sessions with experts in the field, the young people will also prepare their contributions for Bonn. This will include artistic activities.

	Afternoon	Presentation, discussion & activity: Human beings and nature in a relationship of tension – the relevance of biodiversity to development politics
18 May	Afternoon	Biodiversity & art: Presentation of the Ecological Footprint model and setting up the “Flying Footprint” – 16 glass display cases that will contain natural products from around the world
19 May	Afternoon	Creative workshops: Puzzle of Biodiv: making an artwork together – the “Ecological Footprint” in the form of a glass sculpture
24 May	Morning	Biodiversity goes dancing: Youth Summit participants rehearse a dance theatre performance “Go 4 BioDiv!” under the direction of a professional choreographer
	Afternoon	Workshop: Finishing touches to the assignments and presentation of the results by the two groups “Statement/Dialogue” and “Expo”
	Evening	Evening of diversity: Farewell ceremony with the participation of the Bavarian State Minister of the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection, Dr Otmar Bernhard and COP 9 delegates.
